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Practice Development
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Routine Antenatal Anti-D Prophylaxis

- ☞ Recommended by NICE (2002), for all non-sensitised RhD negative women.
- ☞ Each year 25-30 babies die from HDN
- ☞ To reduce the rate of spontaneous abortion before 28 weeks

Preparation for implementation

- ☛ Local guidelines drawn up
- ☛ Information leaflet for the women
- ☛ Consent form for the women
- ☛ A flow chart

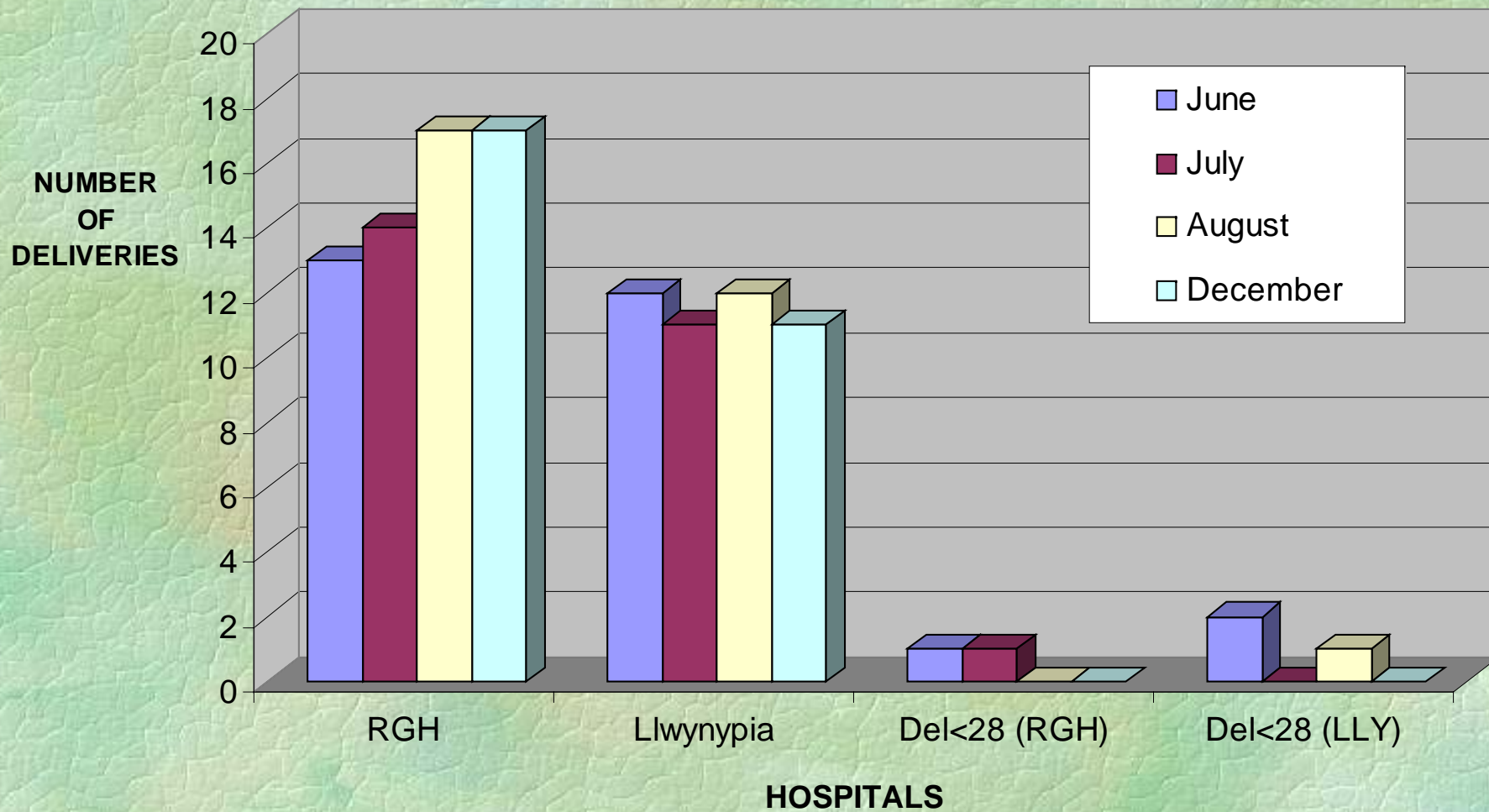
How it was implemented

- ☞ Training for all staff in RGH & Llwynypia
- ☞ Information given to all RhD negative women at 18 weeks
- ☞ Verbal consent obtained, if agreed, then appointment made for 28 weeks

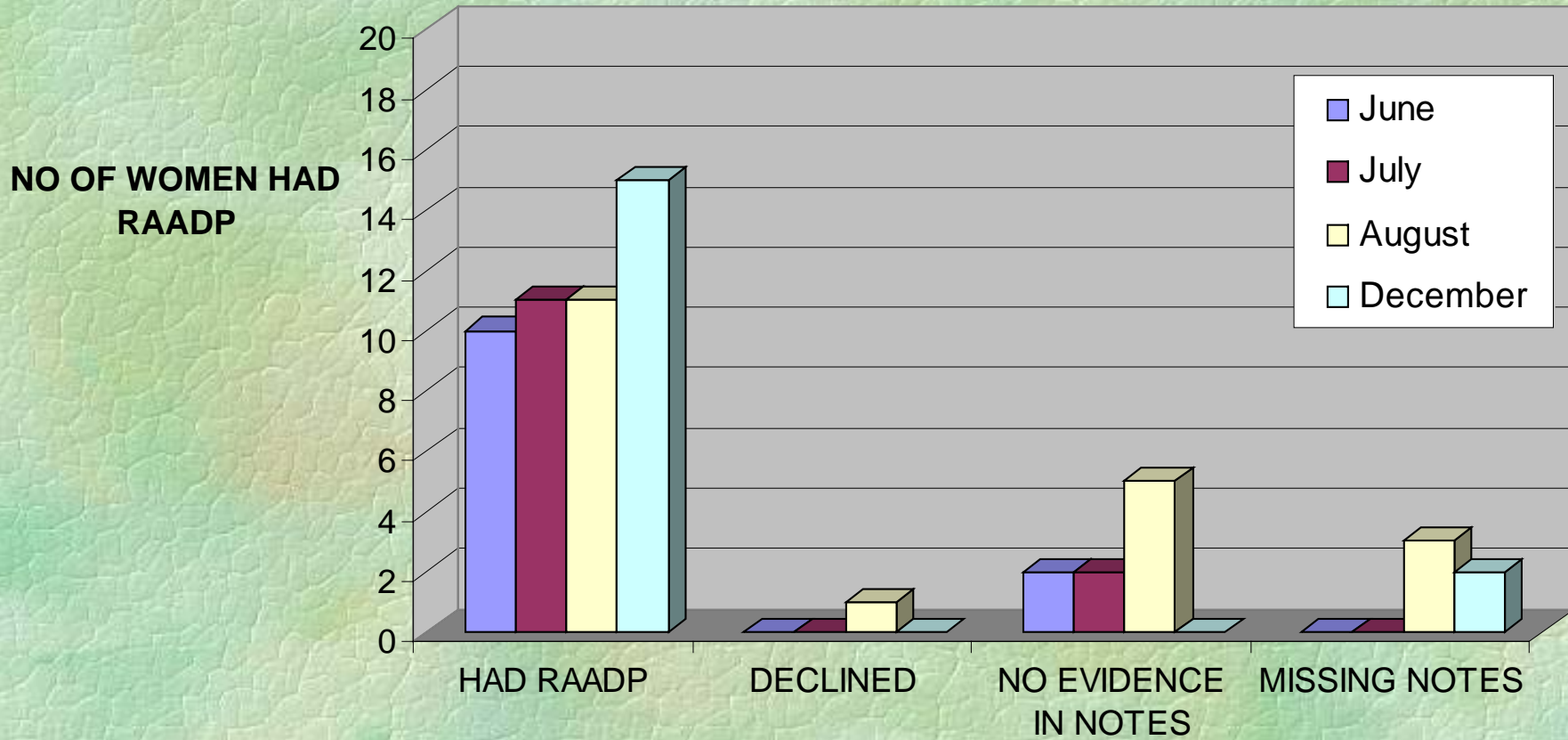
Audits of the uptake rate

- ☛ Audits of June, July & August
- ☛ Initial uptake was a problem especially in Llwynypia
- ☛ Improvement in December
